



2023 Photo Contest

Submission Guidelines

Photo Requirements:

1. The theme of the contest is “Explore Wabakimi!” The videos should highlight the wildlife, camp life, challenges and/or natural beauty encountered when paddling in Wabakimi Provincial Park or the surrounding Crown lands.
2. Photo must be taken by entrant and should not contain any copyrighted material.
3. Entrants may submit up to 3 photos for entry. No entries from prior FOW contests.
4. Photo content must be about canoe travel through Wabakimi Provincial Park and/or surrounding Crown Lands and taken during the 2022-23 seasons..
5. The photo(s) must not contain material that is obscene, defamatory, libelous, pornographic, offensive or encourage conduct that would violate any law. Photos must be appropriate for viewing by the general public and by a multi-cultural international community. No pictograph photos allowed. In addition, photo content must reflect an adherence to provincial park rules/game laws as well as a minimal environmental impact. FOW reserves the right to refuse any photo submissions that they feel are inappropriate.

Submission of Photo Entry/Release Form:

1. Send completed Wabakimi Photo/Video Contest Entry & Release form and digital photo (original up to 10MB) in jpeg format to info@wabakimi.org.
2. If more than 1 entry, each entry should be submitted in similar manner in separate emails.
3. Only submissions meeting all the above guidelines will be considered for official entry.
4. If the contest is not able to run as planned, FOW reserves the right to cancel or modify the contest at their discretion.
