

**Wabakimi Rendezvous
Video Contest, 2022
Guidelines**



Video Requirements:

- 1) The theme of the photo contest is “**Wabakimi Wanderings.**” The videos should highlight the wildlife, camp life, challenges and/or natural beauty encountered when paddling in Wabakimi Provincial Park or the surrounding Crown lands.
- 2) Video length: minimum 2 minutes; maximum 10 minutes
- 3) Video must be written, directed, produced, filmed, edited and created by entrant.
- 4) Entrants may submit up to 2 videos for entry but each requires separate Video Entry/Release form and link.
- 5) Video content must be about entrant’s personal travel through Wabakimi Provincial Park and/or surrounding Crown Lands and filmed during the 2018-2022 seasons.
- 6) The video must not contain material that is obscene, defamatory, libelous, pornographic, offensive or encourages conduct that would be considered a criminal offence or violates any law. Videos must be appropriate for viewing by the general public and by a multi-cultural international community. No pictograph photos allowed. In addition, video content must reflect an adherence to provincial park rules/game laws as well as a minimal environmental impact. FOW reserves the right to refuse any video submissions that they feel are inappropriate.
- 7) Copyrighted music cannot be used unless permission is granted and cited. All other copyrighted material is prohibited. Contest participants must send documents proving use of copyrighted music approval along with video upon submission.
- 8) Submission of Video Entry/Release Forms:
 - a) Send completed Video Contest Entry & Release form and video link (video should be uploaded to YouTube and shared only to those with link) to info@wabakimi.org by deadline.
 - b) If more than 1 entry, each entry should be submitted in similar manner in separate emails.
- 9) Only submissions meeting all the above guidelines will be considered for official entry.
- 10) If the contest is not able to run as planned or if the **Wabakimi Rendezvous** event is canceled, FOW reserves the right to cancel or modify the contest at their discretion.

Timelines:

1. February 2022 – Wabakimi Rendezvous Photo/Video Contest Announcement
2. July 1, 2022 – Submission Deadline
3. Sep 10, 2022 – Winners announced/showcased at **Wabakimi Rendezvous**

Evaluation Criteria

1. Content of video (in line with the theme as stated above)
2. Captivating (keeps audience interest with beauty, action, interesting events, etc)
3. Creativity (original style/filming/added touches)
4. Overall production quality of video (visual/sound quality, steady camerawork, editing, overall presentation)

Evaluation and Selection of Winners

1. Entries will be judged by a committee of 3-5 judges appointed by FOW.
2. Winner and Honorable Mention video entries will be uploaded in the FOW web page and/or FOW Facebook page
